CREATE A PAINTED KÖHATU

Painting kōhatu (stones) is a great way to unleash your inner artist!

YOU WILL NEED

- Köhatu (stones or pebbles) big enough to paint on
- Coloured acrylic paint (small test pots)
- A couple of paintbrushes (different sizes)
- A permanent marker
- Coloured markers (optional)

WHAT TO DO

- 1. Wash and dry your kohatu.
- Paint one side of your kohatu (or leave it natural). When dry, paint the other side.
- 3. Once dry, use your marker to draw pattern outlines.
- 4. Use the small paint brush to paint on designs.

GET CREATIVE!

- Make a special kohatu with the name of a loved one who is no longer here.
- Make small kohatu into magnets for your fridge.
- Use your painted kohatu to decorate your garden.
- Make your very own pet kōhatu (with hair and goggly eyes).
